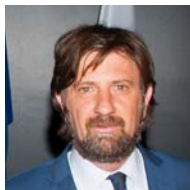
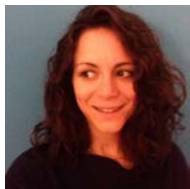

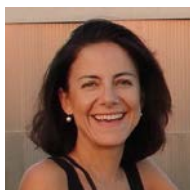
Arch. Alessandro Ridolfi

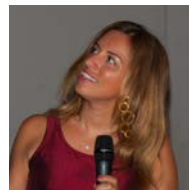
Arch. Valina Geropanta

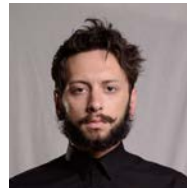
Arch. Cristiana Pacchiarotti **ITAD Artist and Architect**

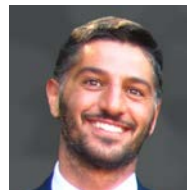
Arch. Gildo Incitti **ITAD Tutor**
